

Packing List

- **Work clothes for 5 Days** (Note: This clothing could be ruined by paint or other building elements!)
 - ❖ Long pants (2-3 pair) - Absolutely NO shorts on the worksites. We highly recommend scrub pants or cotton (not flannel!) pajama pants as they are much cooler.
 - ❖ T-shirts- **No tank tops** or spaghetti straps. No exposed sport bras.
 - ❖ 1 long sleeve shirt- in case you work with insulation.
 - ❖ Old tennis shoes or other sturdy work shoes. **Absolutely NO open-toed shoes**, Crocs, Chocos, sandals, or flip flops **on the work sites**.
 - ❖ 1 pair of work gloves (should be in your bucket)
 - ❖ A hat and/or bandanna (any color)
 - ❖ Sunglasses

- **Evening Clothes for 6 Days**
 - ❖ Modest shorts- fingertip/basketball length
 - ❖ Modest shirts- No tank tops, spaghetti straps, or inappropriate words/graphics. No exposed sport bras.
 - ❖ Pajamas
 - ❖ Undies and socks
 - ❖ Tennis shoes **AND** flip-flops or water shoes for pool & shower

- **OTHER**
 - ❖ Sleeping bag or bed linens & a pillow
 - ❖ **Twin size** air mattress or cot (similar to this one: <http://www.walmart.com/ip/Intex-Twin-Classic-Downy-Airbed-Mattress/20449351>).
 - ❖ Air pump for mattress (optional). See link in email for example.
 - ❖ Towels and washcloth
 - ❖ Toiletries: shampoo, conditioner, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste
 - ❖ Deodorant (NO AXE!!!)
 - ❖ Sunscreen
 - ❖ **Reusable, personal water bottle** or jug **labeled with your name**.
 - **DO NOT PACK THIS ITEM; bring it filled with water to check-in!**
 - ❖ Laundry or trash bag to bring all your sweaty clothes home, **labeled with your name**
 - ❖ Rain jacket or poncho
 - ❖ Chapstick with SPF
 - ❖ Antibacterial wipes or gel hand sanitizer
 - ❖ Insect repellent
 - ❖ Bible, notebook, pencil or pen
 - ❖ Flashlight
 - ❖ One dozen individually wrapped, **peanut-free** snacks to share with your group.

- **CASH:** \$30 to cover non-inclusive meals. **DO NOT PACK THIS MONEY!!** You need it at check-in & during the bus trip.

****No electronics except for cellphones will be permitted. No juuls, e-cigarettes, alcohol, illegal drugs or substances are allowed. And no AXE spray, please!**

Tools:

This year it is optional (but *STRONGLY* recommended) that each student have a bucket of their own tools. After the trip, the student will take their bucket home and can be used on future trips.

These buckets/supplies can be purchased at Home Depot or similar store.

- 5 gallon plastic paint bucket **with lid, name on outside**
- Safety goggles (full protection goggles, not safety glasses)
- Work Gloves
- Hammer
- 25' measuring tape
- Paint scraper
- Screwdriver with Phillips head and flat head
- Paint kit (paint tray, paint roller, 3 paint brushes)
- Sunscreen & Insect Repellant
- Antibacterial wipes and/or gel hand sanitizer
